Carpool to School



Due to the increase of COVID among youth in the state the following carpool guidelines are being implemented beginning Monday, Oct. 4, 2021. Faculty and staff will no longer assist in this effort.

- Students in grades PK-2 grades must exit the vehicle on the right hand side with the assistance of an adult.
- Students in grades 3rd-8th must exit the vehicle by themselves on the right hand of the vehicle.
- If there are multiple siblings all must exit to the right of the vehicle.

MASS ATTIRE Students in grades 6th-8th must dress accordingly for mass:

- **Girls** –Redemptorist green vest, plaid skirt, and Redemptorist long/short sleeve white button-down oxford shirt with white socks or white or grey tights.
 - **Girls in PRE-K-5th** must wear a jumper or skirt with uniform blouse.
- **Boys** – Redemptorist long sleeve white-button down oxford shirt, necktie/bowtie with khaki pants and belt.
 - **Boys in PREK -5th** must wear long uniform pants with uniform shirt.



FALL/WINTER ATTIRE

- In cold weather gear, students may wear the nylon green uniform jacket (solid) or the dark grey Redemptorist Polar Fleece. The **only sweatshirt allowed is the Redemptorist sweatshirt** sold as a fundraiser. Heavy overcoats may be worn outside only. All uniforms and clothing should be properly labeled with the child's name so that if it is lost, it can be returned to the rightful owner.
- STUDENTS MUST ADHERE TO THE SCHOOL DRESS CODE AND GROOMING POLICY. THIS POLICY AS WELL AS ALL OTHERS WILL BE IMPLEMENTED TO THE FULLEST.
