MASS ATTIRE Students in grades 6th-8th must dress accordingly for Mass:

- **Girls** –Redemptorist green vest, plaid skirt, and Redemptorist long/short sleeve white button-down oxford shirt with white socks or white or grey tights.
 - **Girls in PRE-K-5th** must wear a jumper or skirt with uniform blouse.
- **Boys** – Redemptorist long sleeve white-button down oxford shirt, necktie/bowtie with khaki pants and belt.
 - **Boys in PREK -5th** must wear long uniform pants with uniform shirt.

FALL/WINTER ATTIRE

- In cold weather gear, students may wear the nylon green uniform jacket (solid) or the dark grey Redemptorist Polar Fleece. The **only sweatshirt allowed is the Redemptorist sweatshirt** sold as a fundraiser. Heavy overcoats may be worn outside only. All uniforms and clothing should be properly labeled with the child's name so that if it is lost; it can be returned to the rightful owner.

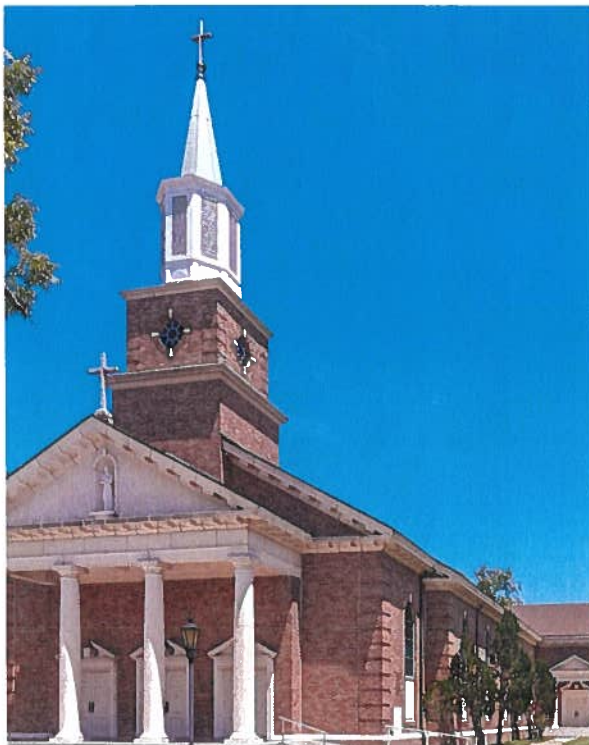
