

Purpose of Lent

Test Taking Strategies

Do you sweat, chew your pencil, and feel butterflies in your stomach as your teacher hands out a test? A lot of people (adults included) get freaked out when it's time to take a test.

It's natural to feel some stress about taking tests. In fact, sometimes a little adrenaline (a hormone made by your body during times of excitement or stress) is a good thing to jump-start you.

Here are some tips for taking tests:

BEACON

Beacon is a powerful tool to help students and their parents monitor progress toward a successful **Beacon test** from third grade through tenth grade. The **Beacon**

test assess students' readiness in five areas covered by the **Beacon test**: English, math, reading, science and writing. Summative testing will be administered March 7 – March 9, 2023.

Acre Testing

Since the late 1970's NCEA has offered assessment instruments designed to strengthen catechetical/religious education programs. The ACRE (Assessment Children/Youth Religious Education) helps schools, parishes and diocesan leaders evaluate the faith knowledge and attitudes of students in Catholic schools. As an integrated assessment tool, ACRE provides faith knowledge questions (cognitive domain) and questions related to religious beliefs, attitudes, practices, and perceptions (affective domain). Students in grades 5 and 8 will be administered this test March 20 - 24, 2023. Please make sure students are on time for the test.

Stations of the Cross

The Stations of the Cross or the Way of the Cross, also known as the Way of Sorrows or the Via Crucis, refers to a series of images depicting Jesus Christ on the day of his crucifixion and accompanying prayers.



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Report Cards

The purpose of a report card is to inform a child's parents of his or her academic progress during the school year. Many parents consider it the MOST important document that they receive from the school. Report cards will be sent home March 28, 2023.
