- Can count, write, and recognize numbers up to 10
- Know the following words
  - Is, it, my, me, no, see, we, the

### Kindergarten

- “A Bad Case of Stripes” by David Shannon (Realistic Fiction)
- Must be able to identify alphabets and their sound
- Must be able to identify and write numbers 1-20
- Must know sight words
  - all, am, are, at, ate, be, black, brown, but, came, did, do,

### First Grade

- “How To Heal A Broken Wing” by Bob Graham (Realistic Fiction)
- Write your first, middle, and last name legibly on the line
- Must recognize sight words
  - come, about, make, many, number, numeral, had, did, which, when, could, should, these, this, what, that, your, or, us, their
- Addition and subtraction facts to 12(no counting on fingers)

### Second Grade

- “The Best Seat in Second Grade by Katherine Kenah (Realistic Fiction)
- Write first, middle and last name legibly on a line
- Addition/subtraction facts 0-12 (no counting on fingers)
- Multiplication facts 0 - 5 (memory- no counting on fingers)
- Must recognize the following sight words
  - The, they, there, school, house, here, where, come, some, could, should, would, improve, money, because, everybody

### Third Grade

- "Harriet the Spy" by Louise Fitzhugh (Realistic Fiction)
- Write first, middle and last name legibly on a line
- Parts of speech (nouns, verbs, adjectives, and adverbs)
- Must know sight words
  - Together, far, bring, only, hurt, keep, own, eight, myself, about, better, drink, laugh, seven, six, cut, done, show, long, small, myself, hot, etc.
- Must know multiplication facts 0-9 without counting on fingers
- Multiplying a 1-digit by a 2 digit
- Dividing a 1-digit by a 2 digit
- Place Value to millions
- Number words

### Fourth Grade

- "The Lemonade Wars" by Jacqueline Davies (Realistic Fiction)
- Identify the parts of speech (nouns, verbs, adjectives, and adverbs)
- Must identify sight words
  - Abrupt, achieve, entertain, permit,, equip
  - Active, exceed, persuade, affect, alter, phase, famished, persist
  - Project, approach, flexible, prepare, attempt, glimpse
- Divisibility rules
- Multiplication facts 0-12
  - Multiply a 1, 2, or 3-digit by a 2 digit
- Division
  - Divide a 2-digit by a 1, 2, or 3-digit number with/without remainder
  - Writing numbers up to 1 million in words
- Addition & Subtraction
  - Adding and subtracting numbers up to five digits
- Counting money

## Fifth Grade

- “Frindle by Andrew Clements (Realistic Fiction)
- Parts of speech (nouns, verbs, adjectives, and adverbs)
- Vocabulary sight words: people, brother, hundred, question, favorite, enough, mountain, quickly, government, development, paragraph, abdicate, equivalent, accommodate, evade, penetrate, accurate
- Multiplication facts 0 -12 by memory
- Convert between standard and expanded form
- Place value
- Divisibility rules
- Multiply and divide by 2, 3, or more digits by a 2 or 3-digit number
- Exponents
- Understanding the power of ten

## Sixth Grade

- “The Lightning Thief” by Rick Riordan (Novel Study)
- Parts of speech (nouns, verbs, adjectives, and adverbs)
- Multiplication facts 0 -12 by memory
- Divisibility rules
- Add and subtract up to 6 digits with or without regrouping
- Divide by 2, 3, or more digits by a 2-4 digit number
- Exponents

## Seventh Grade

- “A Long Walk to Water” by Linda Sue Park (Novel Study)
- Add, Subtract, Multiply & Divide up to 5 digits
- Multiplication facts 0-12 by memory
- Divisibility rules

## Eighth Grade

- “Animal Farm” by George Orwell (Novel Study)
- Divisibility rules

- GCF and LCM
- Scientific Notation
